TERMS & CONDITIONS

BOOKING A SOCIAL BOWLS EVENT

Having contacted Temple BC about a potential bowls event the applicant will be sent the relevant "Social Bowls Booking Form". The form must be completed in full and returned to a Club Official who will assess the application and suitable availability. Should the booking be accepted, the details provided will be used to produce a quote / invoice which will be returned to the applicant and if agreeable the booking will be confirmed once a payment has been made.

MEMBERSHIP OF TEMPLE BOWLING CLUB

In accordance with "Temple Club Rules" social bowling groups / parties will only be accepted if the applicant is a member of the Club. Successful applicants who are not members of Temple, will become Social Members for the day of the event and will be entered onto the Clubs Register as such.

SOCIAL BOWLS PRICING

In general, social bowls groups are booked in two-hour time slots at a cost of £15 per person (£7.50 per hour) bowling on the day. Any special requests / requirements will be assessed and if they incur a cost to the Club will be charged for and included in the quote. Applicants requesting bookings for large parties (more than 20), or longer periods (more than two hours) will again be assessed on an individual basis and pricing may be adjusted accordingly. It should be noted that the quote provided will be deemed by the Club to be a non-negotiable charge for the application provided.

PAYMENT

A booking will be deemed provisional until either 50% or the entirety of the invoice has been paid. Once a payment has been made the booking will be confirmed and the relevant rinks set-aside for the event and documented in all Club diaries. Large parties (over 20) must complete full payment no later than seven days before the event whilst smaller parties having paid the necessary deposit can fulfil payment on the day itself by cash, card, or direct bank transfer. The Club's preferred method of payment is by direct bank transfer with the relevant details listed on the invoice supplied. When making a payment please quote the reference number on your quote / invoice. Cancellations made by the applicant will be refunded only if confirmed with a minimum of seven days' notice. Should, for unforeseen circumstances, the Club cancel the event all monies will be returned within seven days.

DRESS CODE

The Club does not operate a strict dress code but advises all bowlers to wear casual clothing that allow plenty of movement. However, all bowlers are required to wear **flat** shoes or trainers as all heels / treads will be denied entry onto the green. Barefoot bowling is permitted but the Club accepts no responsibility for any potential foot contamination caused by chemicals used to maintain our Greens.

BOWLING, EQUIPMENT & TUITION

The Club will provide all necessary equipment for your bowls event and provide suitable tuition (dependent on the bowling experience of your party) free of charge. Tuition will include general bowling instructions, rules of the game and ongoing individual / group advice during the event itself. A complete novice should be able to play and enjoy the sport within a short period of time.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

The Club has a well-stocked licenced bar which will be open for members and guests during normal opening hours, and alcoholic drinks are only permitted on the premises or grounds if purchased at the bar. Should a party wish to have an "Open" bar during their event please discuss this with a bar steward on the day itself. The Club does not provide a catering service at present, but parties are more than welcome to bring their own food or use a delivery service for your guests (you will however be responsible for clearing / cleaning the area used to its original state).

GENERAL CODES OF CONDUCT

- Children must be supervised, at all times, by a responsible adult.
- With the exception of guide dogs all pets will only be permitted at the discretion of the Clubs Management.
- The member booking the event will be responsible for their guests whilst on the premises and local community.
- All Social Bowlers must take care of the playing surfaces and surrounding areas whilst on the premises.
- Drinks and food items are strictly prohibited from the bowls green itself.
- In accordance with the "Constitution" the Club operates a strict zero-tolerance policy towards any instances of abusive, aggressive or discriminatory behaviour.

CLUB RULES

All members and guests of Temple BC must fully comply with "Temple Club Rules" whilst both on and leaving the premises & surrounding area. Any breach of these rules will lead to the person / persons being removed from Club premises and if applicable, action taken to recover costs for any damage, breakages or reputation incurred.
